

Smoke Free Policy

Dear Tenants,

Hall and Moskow would like to remind you that all of our buildings and apartments are Smoke Free. There should be **no** smoking in any of the units for any reason.

If you must smoke, then it has to be done outside, away from common doorways and other tenants windows. There are many tenants who don't smoke, have allergies, or medical conditions which makes breathing second hand smoke not only uncomfortable, but physically dangerous. We ask that you be mindful of your neighbors at all times.

When smoking outside of the building, you must dispose of your cigarettes and tobacco properly. Throwing them on the ground around the property is not permitted. Please dispose of them in the trash, or a receptical used just for that purpose. (A metal coffee can with a lid would be ideal).

Our Smoke Free Policy has been posted in every building and we ask that you follow this regulation. It is one that promotes a healthy environment, increased safety in the buildings, by reducing the chance of fire, and allows smokers and non-smokers enjoyment of their homes.

Failure to follow this policy may result in termination of your rental agreement.
